Brighton Village Restrictive Covenants... "Runs with the land"

The Restrictive Covenants are for all of us to follow whether you are a *BVNA member, non-member, renter or homeowner*.

The Covenants are on our website at <u>www.brightonvillage.org</u>

<u>Please</u> take time to read them.

Article IV—General land Use. Section 10:

....No boat trailers, boats, travel trailers, inoperative automobiles, campers, vehicles of any kind or portable buildings are to be permanently or semi-permanently stored in the public street right-of-way or on driveways or parking areas....

Restrictive Covenants filed at the Department of Records, Nueces County, Volume 1809 on January 22, 1982.

Guidelines for Restrictive Covenant Enforcements, that were adopted in 1995, gives you a 48 hour window. This time is for loading and unloading.

Thank you for holding to our Covenants and for your commitment in keeping our neighborhood the best in Corpus Christi.

Recipe of the Month Chicken & Cashews

- 3 tablespoons low-sodium soy sauce, divided
- 2 tablespoons dry sherry
- 4 teaspoons cornstarch, divided
- 1 pound skinless, boneless chicken breast, cut into bite-sized pieces
- 1/2 cup fat-free, chicken broth
- 2 tablespoons oyster sauce
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 2 teaspoons sesame oil, divided
- 3/4 cup chopped onion
- 1/2 cup chopped celery
- 1/2 cup chopped red bell pepper 1 tablespoon grated peeled fresh
- I tablespoon grated peeled fres ginger
- 2 garlic cloves, minced 1/2 cup chopped green onions (about 3 green onions) 1/4 cup chopped unsalted dry-
- 1/4 cup chopped unsalted dryroasted cashews
- 1. Combine 1 tablespoon soy sauce, sherry, 2 teaspoons cornstarch, and chicken in a large bowl; toss well to coat. Combine remaining 2 tablespoons soy sauce, remaining 2 teaspoons cornstarch, broth, oyster sauce, and honey in a small bowl.
- 2. Heat 1 teaspoon oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Add chicken mixture to pan; sauté 3 minutes. Remove from pan. Heat remaining 1 teaspoon oil in pan. Add onion, celery, and bell pepper to pan; sauté 2 minutes. Add ginger and garlic; sauté 1 minute. Return chicken mixture to pan; sauté 1 minute. Stir in broth mixture. Bring to a boil; cook 1 minute, stirring constantly. Remove from heat. Sprinkle with green onions and cashews.

Rice pilaf: Heat 1 tablespoon canola oil in a large saucepan over medium-high heat. Add 1/2 cup chopped onion and 2 teaspoons grated peeled fresh ginger to pan; sauté 2 minutes. Stir in 1 cup water, 1/2 cup long-grain rice, and 1/4 teaspoon salt; bring to a boil. Cover, reduce heat, and simmer 12 minutes or until liquid is absorbed. Remove from heat; stir in 2 tablespoons chopped fresh cilantro.
