Brighton Village Restrictive Covenants... "Runs with the land"

The Restrictive Covenants are for all of us to follow whether you

are a

BVNA member, non-member, renter or homeowner.

The Covenants are on our website at <u>www.brightonvillage.org</u> <u>Please</u> take time to read them.

Article IV—General land Use. Section 10:

....<u>No boat trailers, boats, travel trailers,</u> inoperative automobiles, campers, vehicles of any kind or portable buildings are to be permanently or semi-permanently stored in the public street right-of-way or on driveways or parking areas....

Restrictive Covenants filed at the Department of Records, Nueces County, Volume 1809 on January 22, 1982.

Guidelines for Restrictive Covenant Enforcements, that were adopted in 1995, gives you a 48 hour window. This time is for loading and unloading.

Thank you for holding to our Covenants and for your commitment in keeping our neighborhood the best in Corpus Christi.


Recipe of the Month Slow Cooker Short Ribs

- 1 tbsp. canola oil
- 3 lbs. bone-in beef chuck short ribs
- 2 medium onions, peeled and quartered
- 2 medium carrots, cut into large chunks
- 2 medium parsnips, cut into large chunks
- 2 medium turnips, peeled and cut into large chunks
- 4 sprigs fresh rosemary
- 4 sprigs fresh thyme
- 4 sprigs fresh parsley, stems and leaves separated
- 1 tbsp. Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tbsp. spicy brown mustard
- 1 (12-ounce) dark stout beer
- Kosher salt
- Black pepper

Directions

In a large skillet over mediumhigh heat, add the oil. Season the short ribs with salt and pepper. When the oil is hot, brown the short ribs, in batches, until they are browned on all sides, about 3 -4 minutes per side. While the short ribs are browning, place a layer of onion and carrot pieces into the bottom of a slow cooker and season them with salt and pepper. Place the browned meat on top. Add the remaining onions and carrots along with the parsnips and turnips. Tie together the rosemary and thyme with the parsley stems and add them to the pot along with the Worcestershire and mustard. Pour over the stout and add enough water to almost cover the contents. Cover and cook on low for 6-8 hours, or until the meat is very tender. To serve, carefully remove the meat and vegetables from the

slow cooker. Strain the juices. Serve the ribs with the juice and garnish with chopped parsley
