# Brighton Village Restrictive Covenants...

"Runs with the land"

No one likes to live next to boats, travel trailers, junk cars or utility trailers. Your neighbors do not want to start trouble so they say nothing to you but ... They call the President of the BVNA to contact you.

Article IV—General land Use. Section 10:

....No boat trailers, boats, travel trailers, inoperative automobiles, campers, vehicles of any kind or portable buildings are to be permanently or semi-permanently stored in the public street right-of-way or on driveways or parking areas....

This is in our Restrictive Covenants and they "Run with the Land". These Covenants are for all of us to follow whether you are a *homeowner, a renter, member or non-member* The Covenants are on our website for your perusal, www.brightonvillage.org. Please take time to read them.

**Restrictive Covenants** filed at the Dead of Records, Nueces County, Volume 1809 on January 22, 1982.

<u>Guidelines for Restrictive Covenant Enforcements</u>, that were adopted in 1995, gives you a 48 hour window. This time is for loading and unloading.

If you are in violation of any of these, please make other arrangements for your items.

Thank you for holding to our Covenants and for your commitment in keeping our neighborhood the best in Corpus Christi.

### **Stage 2 Water Restrictions**

**Sprinkler Irrigation** - Limited to one day per week, on the trash pick-up day (Our is Friday)

Hand-held and Drip Irrigation -

Allowed any time, any day with soaker hose, bucket or hand-held hose with positive shut-off nozzle

**Car Washing** – Limited to designated watering day; allowed any day at commercial car wash.

Enforcement: Warning 1st then a fine.

#### **NEXT Heavy Brush Set Out**

Will be in February. **DO NOT** set out early or in the street or on the sidewalks. Code Enforcement will have it removed early and it will result in a fine.

# Recipe of the Month Pizza Pockets (Great for the Game)

1 tablespoon olive oil

8 ounces Italian turkey sausage

1 cup tightly-packed arugula (about 1 ounce)

4 ounces cream cheese, room temperature

1/3 cup grated Parmesan, plus 1/4 cup 1/2 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

1 (13.5-ounce) package of storebought pizza crust

All-purpose flour, for rolling out pizza dough

1 egg, beaten (for egg wash)

1 1/2 cups marinara sauce, bought or homemade

Heat the olive oil over medium-high heat in a medium-sized, heavy skillet. Add the sausage and cook until crumbled and golden, about 5 minutes. Add the arugula and cook until wilted. Turn off the heat and let cool about 10 minutes. Add the cream cheese, 1/3 cup Parmesan, salt, and pepper and stir to combine. Set aside. Preheat the oven to 400 degrees F. Roll out the pizza dough on a lightly floured surface to a thin 20 by 12inch rectangle. Cut the rectangle in half lengthwise. The cut each half I into 8 equal rectangles. Spoon topping onto 1 side of each of the rectangles. Using a pastry brush, brush the edges of the rectangle with egg wash. Close the rectangle of pizza dough over the topping. Use a fork to seal and crimp the edges. Place the pizza pockets onto a parchment paper-lined baking sheet. Brush the top of each pizza pocket with egg wash. Sprinkle with the I remaining Parmesan. Bake until golden, about 15 to 17 minutes. Meanwhile, heat the marinara sauce over low heat in a medium saucepan. Serve the hot pizza pockets with the marinara sauce alongside for dipping.


